Preparation

- The objective of this kit is too mount the JD wide fenders (P#: KK61862) onto the narrow fender brackets that come standard on the sprayer.
- To prepare the sprayer, ensure that the narrow fender brackets are installed correctly and that the narrow fenders are removed.
- Have the wide fender kit (BKK11244) close by. The fenders, some hardware and (4) fender straps (KK71774) will be needed from the crate/kit.





Refer to Figures 1–3

To make switching between wide and narrow fenders easier/faster, Lankota recommends drilling access holes in the top of the wide fenders. If you do not want to drill these holes, proceed to Step 6.

- 1. The holes will give access to otherwise inaccessible, bracket bolts.
- 2. On two fenders, from the left-most two holes, measure straight forward 2-1/8" and mark. On the other two fenders, measure and mark from the right-most holes.
- 3. Set a LANMF33L or R on a wide fender by the top holes (as shown) for reference.
- 4. Use a 1.25" hole saw to drill a hole at each mark.
- 5. If needed later, use a die grinder to adjust the holes.

- Install the lower bracket (LAMF32L or R) to the lower mount point using (2) M10 x 80mm flange bolts, curved washers and flange nuts from the JD BKK11244 Kit.
- 7. The mounting holes are offset in the bracket. Ensure the mount is oriented correctly (see Figure 2).
- 8. Snug up the bracket, level the mount and then tighten.

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Refer to Figures 8—11

- 11. Attach the wide fenders to the new brackets. Use (8) M10 x 25mm flange bolts (LAN19M7785) and two straps from the JD Kit for each fender.
- 12. Lankota recommends using thread locking compound to prevent the bolts from vibrating loose.

If holes were drilled in the fenders, make sure they are inwards (toward the sprayer).

When removing the wide fenders,

- If holes were drilled as described previously, all the adapter brackets may be left connected to the fenders
- If holes were NOT drilled, the top adapter and fender must be separated to access the top-down mount bolts. The lower adapter can remain attached.
