

Preparation

If header is installed on combine:

- 1. Raise header to proper height for installation of kits.
- 2. Turn combine engine off.
- 3. Set parking break.

Installation

Refer to Figure 1

1. Remove the factory black wear plates on the inside of the R/H end snout. Retain all hardware for later use. Make sure bushings stay in place.

Refer to Figure 2

- 2. Install end row inside snout protector (LANPSP702R) to inside of R/H end snout. Attach using seven of the stainless steel screws, one bolt and one nut from the LANPSPBH bag of hardware and the factory six bolts and nuts previously removed.
- 3. Repeat on L/H side of head with LANPSP702L.

Installation

- 4. Install end row outside snout protector (LANPSP703R) to outside of R/H end snout using thirteen of the stainless steel screws, one bolt and one nut from the LANPSPBH bag of hardware.
- 5. Repeat on L/H side of head with LANPSP703L.

Refer to Figures 3 & 4

- 6. Remove the factory black wear plates from both sides the remaining middle snouts. Retain all hardware for later use. Make sure bushings stay in place.
- Install standard snout protectors (LANPSP701L & R) to the corresponding side of the remaining snouts using seven of the stainless steel screws, one bolt and one nut from the LANPSPBH bag of hardware and the factory six bolts and nuts previously removed.
