Disclaimer

This kit from LANKOTA adds 1300 lbs. to the front of a tractor. Never exceed manufacturer's specified load limit on the front of a tractor! This may mean that weights or a weight bracket may need to be removed from the tractor to install this kit.

WARNING: After completing installation, be careful around the wings the first dozen or so times they are folded/unfolded. The process of purging the air from the hoses can cause the wings to jerk up and down dangerously and unexpectedly.

Preparation

- 1. Park on a flat and level surface.
- 2. Turn steering wheel so tractor straight.
- 3. Set the parking brake.

Installation

1. Open the engine hood.

Refer to Figures 1 & 2

- 2. Remove the front hood seal shrouds (both sides). Save the hardware for reinstall later.
- 3. Remove the toolbox. Set the bracket aside for later, but the hardware will not be used again.



4. One at a time, remove and replace the (4) flange head bolts on the sides of the radiator frame with an M16 x 80mm bolt (LANFE10A) and a M16 washer (LANF-FW-M16). Tighten bolts.

- 5. Using a forklift or other suitable lifting device, raise the spacer bracket (LANSR9R270L) into place under the M16 bolts.
- 6. Secure with (2) of M16 washer, 5/8" lock washer and M16 nut (LANF-FW-M16, REDWL57 and LAN14M7259). Do not tighten, only snug.
- 7. Insert (2) 3/4" x 2.5" hex bolts (LANFB810) with 3/4" washers (REDWU58) through the bracket and frame.
- 8. Secure with (2) of 3/4" washer and 3/4" top lock nut (REDWU58 and REDKRJG) Do not tighten; snug one of them.
- 9. Completely tighten the M16 nuts/bolts, then the 3/4" nuts/bolts.
- 10. Repeat on other side with LANSR9R270R.



- 11. Ideally the top mounting bolts in LANSR005 should be approx. 29" to 31" off the ground. Use either set of mounting holes to achieve this. Using a forklift or suitable lifting device, hold LANSR005 up to the tractor mounting brackets and attach using the 5/8" bolts (REDB712), washers (LANFWS57), and serrated lock nuts (LAN690830).
- 12. Plastic washers (LANSR009) are provided to eliminate metal to metal contact between the wing frames (LANSR006 & LANSR007) and the mount frame (LANSR005). Make sure these are in place in the following steps.
- 13. Using the pivot pin (LANSR008) attach the wing frames to the mount frame. Retain the pivot pin with the provided 1/2" bolt (LANFC507) and lock nut (RED1F30). When in the driver's seat, LANSR006 will be on your left, and LANSR007 will be on your right.

- 14. Install the hydraulic cylinders (LANW250100-S) with included pins. Make sure the ports are facing toward the tractor and that the rod end is connected to the wing frames (LANSR038 & LANSR039).
- 15. When the cylinder is completely extended, the wing frame should be parallel to the ground. There is room for minor adjustments by screwing the clevis in/out of the rod.



- 16. Attach three row mounts (LANSSTFM) to each of the stalk roller assemblies (LANSR035) using the 5/8" carriage bolts (RED706K) and serrated flange nuts (LAN690830).
- 17. Using the provided 5/8" U-bolts (LAN079UBOLT) and serrated flange nuts (LAN690830), attach the row mounts to the stalk roller wing frames (LANSR038 & LANSR039).
- 18. Slide the roller left or right along the wing to cover the track. Make sure the inner end of the roller is in-line with or outside the hinge pin as shown.

NOTE: The roller drum will be angled toward the back of the tractor.

NOTE: Use the hydraulic schematic on the previous page as a reference for the following hydraulic installation procedures.

Refer to Figure 14 & 15

- 19. Attach a straight fitting on the base end of the cylinder and a 90 degree fitting on the rod end of the cylinder. A 28" hose will be attached to the straight fitting. A 40" hose will be attached to the 90 degree fitting. Do this on each cylinder.
- 20. Both sets of hoses will meet up and attach to the tee fittings in the middle. Make sure cylinder base hoses are together and rod end hoses are together. Also make sure that the hoses have enough freedom to move as the wing frames rotate up 90 degrees. Attach the two 312" hoses to the tee fittings and route them under the front end of the tractor.



21. Tape the ends of the 310" Hyd Hoses (LANHH4J6-310) closed and together.


22. Route the hoses as shown. (Follow the blue arrows.)







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Secure the hoses with zip ties wherever necessary.

23. Connect the tee, adapter and pioneer hydraulic fittings together. Attach to the rear end of the 310" hoses and tighten.

- 24. Plug into a set of hydraulic ports.
- 25. Run the hydraulics up and down to purge the air from the lines and cylinders.



26. Two pins (LANSS704) are included to hold the wing frames UP during long term storage. The purpose is to keep the hydraulic cylinders from settling. An extra hole is provided for storage of the pin while the rollers are in use.

Storage Position


Operating Position

- 27. If equipped with a tow cable kit, use the cable stow hook (LAN8RTC007) and stow latch (LANJDTC105) to hold up the end of the cable. Connect the two with a 5/8" x 1-3/4" bolt (REDB707), bronze bushing (LANF-BZBS-0.69-0.50), 5/8" washer (LAN26000), and 5/8" top lock nut (REDKRJF).
- 28. Depending on the cable length, use the $5/8" \times 4"$ U-bolt (LAN2600UBOLT) on the front center tube, or the $5/8" \times 2-5/8"$ U-bolt on the rear center tube.





Headlight Clearance Consideration

Refer to Figures A, B & C

If additional light clearance is required, install cylinder stops (LANSCA-1) as necessary (one or two) on each cylinder to hold the roller arms away from the lights.

Note: The cylinder stops will need to be removed in order to utilize the storage pin position (See






