Preparation

- 1. Attach desired header to the combine. Lock the head to the combine.
- 2. Raise the head off the ground and lower the safety stop on the feeder house cylinder.
- 3. Set the parking brake on the combine.
- 4. Turn off the combine engine and remove the key.



- 1. Remove the shield behind rows 5, 6, 7, & 8.
- 2. Remove the curtain segment behind rows 5 & 8.

- 3. Install the LANSS2606L/R brackets on rows 6 & 7 as described in the instructions packaged with the LANSS260)XO kit.
- 4. Attach 2 of the LANSSCIH4400B brackets to the main toolbar shown behind rows 5 & 8.

Hardware:

LAN690830 5/8" Serrated Flange Nut LAN2600UBOLT 4" U-bolt

- 5. Remove the curtain segment between rows 2&3, 3&4, 9&10, 10&11. (Only necessary on chopping head).
- 6. Attach 4 of the LANSSCIH4400B brackets to the main toolbar between the rows in the last step.

Hardware:

LAN690830 5/8" Serrated Flange Nut LAN2600UBOLT 4" U-bolt

7. Tighten all hardware.

8. Install the 52" toolbar between the first two LANSSCIH4400B mounts, next to the feeder house. The bar should be flush with the inside of the first bracket. Use 1 LAN600UBOLT on each LANSSCIH4400B mount as shown.

Hardware: LAN600UBOLT LAN690830

U-bolt 5/8" x 2.5" 5/8" Serrated Flange Nut

9. Using the 5/8" x 4.5" bolts and washers, loosely attach the LANSS600JBLK splice plate to the second LANSSCIH4400B mount as shown. Also attach the LANSS659 flip up mount to the inside LANSSCIH4400B mount.

 5/8" x 4.5" Bolt

 5/8" Washer

 LAN690830
 5/8" Serrated Flange Nut

10. Slide the 77" toolbar into the splice plate and the outer LANSSCIH4400B mount.

Hardware:

LAN600UBOLT LAN690830 U-bolt 5/8" x 2.5" 5/8" Serrated Flange Nut

11. Tighten all hardware.

12. Continue installing the LANSS659 row mounts centered in line with each row as shown.

Hardware: LAN600UBOLT U-bolt 5/8" x 2.5" LAN690830 5/8" Serrated Flange Nut

13. Tighten all attaching hardware.

14. Bolt the Stalk Stomper shoe (LANSS651) to the flip up mount (LANSS659). Tighten and secure. Use the flip up option of the flip up mounts to clear tires on trailers.
